The children have all completed their end of year exams and have finished school for this year. They start the next school year in January. Several of the children have had chicken pox and have been quite unwell. Jesca has also been very unwell and has been in hospital. She is taking the children to visit Claire and Kennedy for a day, a good opportunity to spend some quality time together. Claire will do some basic medical training with them, particularly regarding malaria testing and early treatment.

Kevin, Julie and Geoff will visit the Grace 24 project when they go to Kenya 15th to 25th January, and they will also spend time with Claire and Kennedy who live a couple of hours from the project, and are our link on the ground with Grace 24. Please pray that this is a helpful visit for everyone and for us as we offer support and encouragement to those at the project and seek wisdom for the future.

Thank you to everyone who helps support Grace 24. It could not run without your donations which pay school fees, medical costs, regular medication for those with HIV, food and clothing for all the 11 children linked with this project. Plus many other needs as they arise.
