## Grace 24 May update

This month Samantha (the little girl abandoned by grandmother who now lives with Jescah) has been very ill. She was admitted to hospital where she initially tested positive for malaria, however, after tests and a blood transfusion she needed to have an operation. Jescah stayed with Samantha throughout her hospital stay. Samantha has had the operation, which went well, and she has been discharged from hospital with ongoing medication. Please pray for this little girl, she is 8 years old and since she has been with Jescah she has been treated for malaria and typhoid and now this problem with her digestive system, as well as the trauma of being abandoned.

Claire and Kennedy are returning to the UK at the end of April for three months, Claire will have her third baby here in May. Kennedy visited the Grace 24 project last week, spent time with Josiah and Jemimah and took some photos. Jescah was at the hospital with Samantha and the other children were at school. Josiah hopes to do a college course in agriculture and is saving towards this. Jemimah would like to train to be a midwife and is getting all her documentation ready to apply to a course. Please pray for wisdom for these two young adults as they plan their futures. Many thanks to all who support this project, both with prayer and financial support, you are appreciated.
